


From the airport: The best way from the airport into the city is using the metro. Tickets can be purchased from the transit company (DSB) at the airport and it takes approximately 20-25 minutes to get directly downtown. Here is a [link](#) for information from the airport. Within the city, the ideal way to get around is by S-Trains; the simplest way is to switch from the metro to the S-Train at Nørreport station.

These hotels are reasonably priced and have good transport connections to the city and the school:

"Steel House", youth hostel, close to Vesterport station (S-Train).
